We gratefully accept on a regular basis donations of:

- Socks
- Gloves, winter hats, scarves
- Backpacks
- Boots or other winter-appropriate footwear adult sizes, mens and womens
- Bottled water
- Powdered hot chocolate mix
- Powdered lemonade mix
- Coffee, powdered coffee creamer
- Sugar
- Milk (fresh or powdered)
- Pantry staples/supplies
- Commercially-processed meat (game meat okay, as long as it's commercially processed)
- Individual, pre-packaged snack items/meal replacement bars (Granola bars, cup o' soups, etc.)
- Chapstick
- Hand sanitizer individual sized and large sized
- Travel size deodorants, mens and womens
- Kleenex, paper towels, paper napkins, toilet paper
- Clorex wipes, liquid dish soap, 409, liquid hand soap, laundry detergent, fabric softener
- Cough drops, bandaids, Tylenol, ibuprofen, athlete's foot spray

We are unable to accept:

- Summer or spring clothing or shoes
- Household items, furniture
- Office furniture
- Expired food, or open food containers

We suggest you donating these items to the Salvation Army, 2nd Edition or the Heirlooms for Hospice stores in Delta, all of which support the shelter and its guests - which means your donations will still impact the lives of homeless and hungry in our community.
